## June's Guest Speaker: S Kay Young - Fine Art Photographer

Of Cherokee descent, she describes herself as an "urban Indian" who became enamored of photography from an early age, acknowledging that "Photography began as inspiration from paintings and a lust for immediate, finished art." After a decades-long accumulation of a trove of silver prints, cibachromes, and film stills numbering in the thousands, Young shifted her emphasis to the sizable (some more than five feet in height), labor-intensive, digitally manipulated images that have consumed her art making to the present.

Young's film of a journey into the forest with a band of nascent photographers, shown on PBS's "Detroit Performs," was awarded an Emmy for documentary shorts.

Young studied photography at College for Creative Studies, followed by a ten year position at the Detroit Institute of Arts. She then served as adjunct instructor of photography at OCC, and is currently instructor for the Peacock Art Club -- art for special needs adults -- at the SHAC. Her class meets every Thursday from 4:00 to 6:00 pm.

Please come to our meeting at the SHAC this month for Kay's presentation and to see her awe-inspiring photographs.

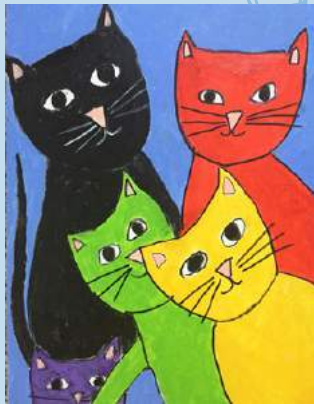
