Current and past students of the SHAC as well as high school and middle school-age students living within the Huron Valley school district are invited to bring one or two pieces of artwork to the Suzanne Haskew Arts Center for our special student art exhibit.

Conditions of Participation:

- Entrants may bring up to 2 pieces of art, in any medium, either 2 or 3-D, along with a completed entry form. See hours below.
- Artists can put their art in as for sale or not for sale, setting their own price that they think is fair. The profit, if it sells, is 100% theirs.
- Art will be dropped off at the SHAC on
 - Friday, Feb. 12th, 10 am - 2 pm;
 - Saturday, Feb. 13th, 10 am - 2 pm;
 - Monday, Feb. 15th, 10 am - 2 pm
 - Tuesday, Feb. 16th, 10 am - 2 pm
- Artists whose work is accepted agree to leave their artwork at the SHAC for the duration of the show, February 17 to March 12, 2021.
- The VFAA reserves the right to refuse any artwork that is submitted.
- Artwork will be picked up after the show ends on March 12 - 16 during office hours: Friday, Saturday, Monday, Tuesday 10 am - 2 pm.
- Only original artwork. Only 2-D artwork smaller than 30"x30" (including the frame). 3-D work should be less than 20 lbs. Acceptable mediums include painting, drawing, digital art, photography, crafts, fiber art, ceramics, mixed media, computer design, and sculpture.

Preparation:

- 2-D art must be framed or matted in black or white, plus mounted with a rigid backing of mat-board, or cardboard (but not railroad board).
- Framed work must have frames in good condition with a wire on the back to hang it from. Unframed Oils and Acrylics done on canvas must also be wired and their edges finished.
- All artwork, 2-D and 3-D, needs to have the provided tag stating the student's name, grade and school, along with their artwork's title, medium and whether it's for sale (price) or NFS, taped onto the backside's upper right-hand corner or on the bottom of their piece.
